TEXTBOOK:

Chemical Principles The Quest for Insight, 5th Ed., by Peter Atkins & Loretta Jones. This textbook, solutions manual, study guide, and model building kit are available as one bundled package at the UCLA bookstore. The <u>same textbook bundle is used in Chem 14A</u> <u>and Chem 14B</u> and the <u>model building kit is used in Chem 14A/B/C/D</u>.

If you buy everything as separate items you will end up paying much more than the above bundled package. For example the identical model building kit which is used in Chem 14C and 14D sells for \$72.47 (\$66.64 + \$5.83 tax) by itself at the UCLA bookstore.

Additional Comments:

There are a number of similar textbook questions from students so here are additional comments.

Students are asking questions about the bundled package sold at the UCLA bookstore for \$184 (new). Let's see how this breaks down.

The identical model building kit which is used in Chem 14C and 14D sells for \$72.47 (\$66.64 + \$5.83 tax) by itself at the UCLA bookstore.

The UCLA bookstore will also buyback (at the end of Chem 14B) for 50% of what you paid. This automatically reduces the \$184 to \$92 for the entire package.

No bookstore, including UCLA's, will buy back any older editions. (Actually they will but for \$3-\$5 ...). So if you buy any older editions you are stuck with them.

After subtracting the cost of the model building kit (and the Solutions Manual & Study Guide) and the bookstore buyback - the cost of the new edition (as a bundled package) is likely to cost less than older editions.

Note that students often keep their general chemistry textbook and lecture notes as a chemistry reference for other courses and when preparing for the MCAT, DAT, etc.
